Impact of Improper Waste Management

HEALTH

 22 human diseases are linked to improper solid waste management

 Trash burning pumps tonnes of cancer causing smoke into the air.

SOCIAL

 Waste pickers families live in unhygienic environments, resulting in malnutrition, extreme poverty, and adverse health infections.

> Waste pickers are affected by respiratory diseases, physical cuts, worm infestations, and skin diseases.



CLIMATE CHANGE

- Burning garbage is the 3rd largest cause of greenhouse emissions in India and links to asthma, heart attack, and emphysema.
- Landfills emit methane that is 21 times as potent as CO2.
- Burning releases lethal gases releasing 6% of methane emissions from garbage in India (vs. 3% globally)
- Rotten garbage leakage contains toxic liquid and is absorbed into the soil and water bodies, and contaminates the food chain.
